Mon, November 9th 9:00 a.m. - 11 a.m.	Module 1: History & Models in our Work	Root causes of violence, human rights, previous landmarks in DSV legislation, current legislation and its influences, and the models/theories in our work.
Mon, November 9th 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.	Module 2: Power & Identity I	Social Identity, accountability, stereotypes, privilege and oppression, systems of unequal power, racial microaggressions, and reparative responses to oppression.
Tues, November 10th 9:00 a.m. - 11 a.m.	Module 3: Power & Identity II	Sex, gender, & orientation, stereotypes, the gender unicorn, power/privilege, oppression, and intersectionality.
Tues, November 10th 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.	Module 4: Media & Culture	Media messages from society and what role power, privilege, and oppression plays in media that glamorizes and encourages sexual violence. Defining culture, the difference between cultural humility, cultural safety, and cultural competency.
Thurs, November 12th 9:00 a.m. - 11 a.m.	Module 5: DV 101 & Abusive Values	Defining DV and the different types of abuse, as well as the cycle of violence and common effects of DV. Review the 6 values of people who abuse usually hold. Anger management v. RESPECT, and cycle of change.
Thurs, November 12th 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.	Module 6: Children/ Parenting & DV	Effects of DV on children, what children learn, and ACEs. Parents who experience abuse v. those who perpetrate abuse, visitation, custody information/family dynamics.
Fri, November 13th 9:00 a.m. - 11 a.m.	Module 7: Safety Planning & Crisis Intervention	SAFEPLAN and court orders, safety planning, tech safety, and crisis intervention.
Fri, November 13th 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.	Module 8: Sexual Violence	Circles of Sexuality, SV 101, consent, stats and facts, rape culture. Increased risks and additional barriers to resources for vulnerable populations.
Mon, November 16th 9:00 a.m. - 11 a.m.	Module 9: Child Sexual Abuse & Human Trafficking	CSA 101, responding to disclosures of CSA, working with adult survivors of CSA. Trafficking video, definition of trafficking, recruitment tactics, sex work v. sex trafficking.
Mon, November 16th 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.	Module 10: SANE	Exam logistics, toxicology, STIs, emergency contraception, additional resources for survivors, SANE providers/map, survivors' rights, and reporting options. Advocate role plays in responding to SANE calls.
Tues, November 17th 9:00 a.m. - 11 a.m.	Module 11: Trauma 101	Definition of trauma, types of trauma, 5 responses to trauma and common effects. Chemical reactions, tonic immobility, fear circuitry & memories, and processing trauma.
Tues, November 17th 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.	Module 12: Mental Health & Mental Illness	Mental health 101, prevention of suicide, addressing suicide, important of language around suicide and mental illness, warning signs, and protective factors.
Wed, November 18th 9:00 a.m. - 11 a.m.	Module 13: Trauma Informed Care	Person-centered practice and trauma informed advocacy. Discusses reflective listening, motivational interviewing and other practices. Maintaining healthy boundaries as advocates.
Wed, November 18th 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.	Module 14: Secondary Trauma & Self-Care	Overview and prevention of secondary trauma and burnout. Self-care information and practices.
